

Recital Day Reminders & FAQs

Photos & Video

- Will there be a professional video of the show?
 - Yes, all dancers will receive a copy of the group recital performances as part of their recital registration.
- Are cameras allowed in the theater?
 - No. Due to theater regulations and dancer safety, no still cameras, video cameras or device recordings of any kind are allowed.
- Will there be pictures taken?
 - Yes, there will be a picture week at the studio. It will take place June 8th-13th during your dancers' regularly scheduled class(es). (This is also dress rehearsal week.) Individual or buddy pictures, as well as personal mini-shoots, will also be available. Photographs will be taken by Rachel Scott Photography. Forms will be available at the front desk.

Costumes & Make-Up

- How much do costumes cost?
 - Costumes are \$90 plus tax per class that your dancer participates in. Dancers participating in 3 or more classes are eligible for costume discounts.
- When will they receive their costume?
 - Costume distribution will take place April-May, depending upon costume availability.
- What if my dancer's costume needs an alteration?
 - All minor alterations are the responsibility of the parent.
- Backstage Costume Changes
 - Any dancers participating in more than one dance will change in their dressing room. Faculty are available to help dancers as needed.
 - NEW: To support smooth and efficient costume changes backstage, dancers will remain in their dressing rooms when changing and may not use the restrooms for costume changes. If your dancer is more comfortable with additional coverage, a nude-colored leotard worn under costumes is recommended. This option maintains modesty while allowing faculty to focus on dancer safety and timely transitions.
- What color shoes and tights does my child need for the show?
 - Ballet classes: Weissman's Pink Ballet Shoes and Weissman's "Ballet Pink" Tights
 - Tap classes: Black oxford style shoe with solid sole and Weissman skin color tights
 - Hip Hop classes: Weissman Hip Hop Shoe & Weissman skin color tights
 - Jazz classes: Your dancer will have (2) options for Weissman Jazz Slip On Shoe color, Carmel or Skin Tone 60. Choose whichever color best matches your dancer's skin tone. If you chose Carmel Shoes, the tights your dancer needs is Light Suntan. If you picked Skin Tone 60 Shoes, your dancer needs Maple Tights. Tights: Weissman Transition Tights Light Suntan or Maple.
 - Lyrical classes: ½ soles that match their skin tone and no tights

- Is there a dress rehearsal?
 - There will be a dress rehearsal week at the studio. June 8th- June 13th. This takes place during your dancers' regularly scheduled class(es). (This is also picture week.) They are to arrive in the appropriate tights, shoes and with their costume on. Hair should be slicked back into a low bun with a center part, no bangs. Stage makeup on.

Costumes and Makeup Cont.

- How should my child wear their hair?
 - All female dancers' hair should be slicked back into a low bun with a center part, no bangs. All male dancers' hair should be worn so that it stays out of their eyes, using gel/product as necessary
- What makeup should my child wear?
 - Dancers should wear neutral tones on their eyes, blush, and bright-colored lipstick, red or dark pink. Fake eyelashes are optional; if not worn, dancers should wear mascara.

Tickets

- When do tickets go on sale?
 - Tickets will go on sale May 18, 2026 at 6:00 pm.
- Where do I purchase tickets?
 - Tickets will be available for purchase online from the homepage of our website.

- How much do they cost, and is it assigned seating?
 - Tickets will be between \$25 and \$35 each, depending upon the selected section of the auditorium. It is assigned seating.
- Which show should I buy tickets for?
 - Prior to ticket sales, we will post which performance all classes will be participating in.

Show Day Information

- Are parents allowed backstage?
 - No, Dancers will be checked in at the door and escorted by volunteers or faculty to join their class.
- When is the annual show?
 - Shows will be on Saturday, June 20th. There will be a matinee and evening show.
- Will my child's class perform in every show?
 - No! Every dance is performed in only one show*. The show lineups can be found on the recital page of our website.
 - *If your child is in more than one dance or if you have multiple dancers, we cannot guarantee that both dances/dancers will be in the same show.
